

# Sunday School Volunteer Descriptions

## Sunday School Teacher (High School through Adult)

Teach a Sunday School class about once per month using the Whirl Lectionary Curriculum. Teachers will teach the same class all year (Preschool, K/1<sup>st</sup> Grade, 2<sup>nd</sup>/3<sup>rd</sup> Grade, or 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup> Grade). All materials will be provided. Teachers will be given access to SparkHouse Digital, which will have leader guides, sample student leaflets, and more (all of which can be accessed by computer, tablet or smart phone)! Lessons are VERY easy to follow, SUPER fun and engaging, and involve very little preparation.

## Sunday School Assistant (6<sup>th</sup> Grade through Adult)

Assist in a Sunday School classroom about once per month. You can request to assist in a certain class consistently or change classes each time you volunteer. There is **NO** planning or preparation involved as an Assistant.

## Substitute Sunday School Teacher/Assistant

Possibly fill in for a Sunday School Teacher or Assistant if someone is unable to be at church for a time they signed-up for.

## Food Drives

Help organize and/or assist with one or more Food Drives throughout the year. Responsibilities can include helping to plan, helping Sunday School children organize donated items, packing items, and/or delivering donated items to their destination(s).

## Christmas/Advent Program

Help plan, organize, assist during the event, and/or help with set up or clean up.

## Easter Egg Hunt

Help plan, organize, assist during the event, and/or help with set up or clean up.
